 - a. Fred Moore gave an update that our 2017 Emergency Response Plan has been updated to reflect current Tier II Reports received

- D. HMEP Grant Updates HMEP grant to cover hotel costs for two (2) LEPC members to attend the annual IEMA Training Summit; Connie also indicated that FY2019-2021 HMEP grant application to be coming out in next couple months and it will be another three (3) year grant period
- E. LEPC support update: Connie informed the LEPC that donation invoices went out early May and to date the LEPC has received \$3,400.00 in support (a spreadsheet was distributed)
- F. Citizen Corps Update: Fred Moore informed the LEPC that he had no update for Citizen Corps

Medical Reserve Corps: Julie Kerestes informed the LEPC that the Medical Reserve Corps has applied for a \$5,000.00 grant to continue their efforts on the Narcan Program; also indicated that the Medical Reserve Corps coordinates the LaSalle County Substance Abuse Coalition and their next meeting is July 26th 1:00pm held here at the EMA Building

Miscellaneous: None

New Business:

Presentation - Dan Quick & Taylor Smith gave a presentation on Enbridge Pipeline within LaSalle County

Plant/Pipeline Updates:

- Sabic indicates they've gone 17 months without a recordable injury; they've gone 1 year without a contractor recordable injury; heat safety has been an ongoing issue with temperature & humidity conditions lately, but no injuries so far; no environmental incidents and they have open positions
- Flint Hills has had no environmental incidents and are searching for a new plant manager, hope to have one in the next couple weeks
- REG Seneca has gone 270 days since their last OSHA recordable injury and 1686 days since their last lost time incident and no reportable environmental incidents since the last meeting
- Carus Chemical reports:
 - Safety-Carus has gone 113 days without a recordable injury and 402 days since the last lost time injury at the LaSalle plant. Our one recordable this year, was related to an employee getting a dust particle of potassium permanganate in their eye. In 2017, we had 2 recordable incidents and a Total Recordable Incident Rate (TRIR) of 1.66. We have worked hard on following up on injuries and look to continue to better our record through audits, job safety analyses, and other safety programs.
 - Environment-no environmental issues or incidents to report; recently won two (2) sustainability awards from the American Chemistry Council for (1) nitrate waste recovery project where we converted a constituent in our wastewater stream into a saleable product, reducing nitrates by 64% in 2017 (2) Another project to reduce plant water consumption through engineering, where reductions of 265 million total gallons/30% were realized
 - o **Security**-No security incidents to report

LaSalle County Emergency Management Advisory Committee – Fred Moore presented that LaSalle County Emergency Management Agency is considering pursuit of Emergency Management Accreditation Program (EMAP) Accreditation and explained that it consists of 64 standards on an international level – the goal is to enhance our current program and make it more efficient; also indicated that the LEPC would serve as the chemical awareness and preparedness portion of that process and if anyone on the LEPC is interested in serving on this

community stakeholder committee to let Connie or Fred know so you can get on the email list; there are read ahead documents so we can make the best of our time as we're going through our entire Emergency Operations Plan
